To bridge the gap, students should undergo in at least one industry internship during the period of study so that they can get a hands on experience needed in industry. Students should be counselled to have effective communication, better attitude and commitment when they get into industry.

Congratulated J.Subhasini, final year EIE student who was awarded ISA scholarship of Rs.1.4 Lakhs from International society of Automation, USA for the year 2018. She is one among 60 awardees globally and two from India. Around 16 MOUs were signed with companies and industries, and 4 MOUs were signed with international universities in the academic year 2018-19.
