Sir/Madam,

This has reference to the proposal submitted by Kumaraguru College of Technology, Post Box No. 2034, Chinnavedampatti, Coimbatore, Tamilnadu affiliated to Anna University, Chennai for extension of autonomous status under the UGC Scheme for Autonomous Colleges.

On the decision(s) of the Standing Committee constituted by University Grants Commission, in its meeting(s) held on 19.06.2020 and 26.06.2020, the Competent Authority has decided to extend the autonomous status to **Kumaraguru College of Technology, Post Box No. 2034, Chinnavedampatti, Coimbatore, Tamilnadu** affiliated to **Anna University, Chennai** for a period of Five (05) years from the session 2019-2020 to 2023-2024 as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.3 of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018.

The University is requested to issue necessary notification/order regarding extension of autonomous status to the College as per the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018 for Autonomous Colleges. The College, if eligible, shall apply for autonomy grant as per the norms laid down in the Regulations.

The Autonomous College is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The Regulations are available on the UGC website, [www.ugu.ac.in](http://www.ugu.ac.in). Non compliance of the requirements and conditions in the said Regulations shall attract action as per Clause -14 of the UGC Regulations – 2018. Further, it may be noted that the above said college shall also apply in the prescribed format to University Grants Commission for extension of autonomous status six months prior to the expiry of the autonomous cycle.
