Academic Innovation

PROTOSEM

PROTOSEM is a first-of-its-kind program that embeds an innovation centred approach to engineering education right into the internal core of the engineering curriculum - innovation aimed at engineering tech enabled solutions for real-world industrial problems. FORGE in collaboration with the Kumaraguru College of Technology [KCT] launched PROTOSEM (shorter version for Prototyping Semester), a full-semester curriculum integrated program offered independently by the Incubator. This course is currently completed by 5 of our 3rd year CSE students in the fifth semester. Students ideate, design & engineer permanently deployable/usable solutions with the guidance of industry experts, and validate rigorously the potential of their innovative ideas to become commercially viable products that generate sustainable and profitable revenues.

Outcome of the Program: It creates a higher level of confidence among the students to pursue innovation and entrepreneurship as their primary career path after graduation.

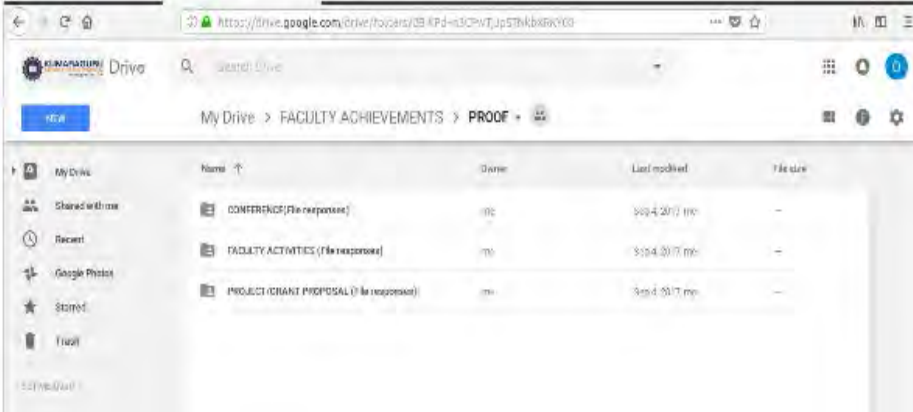

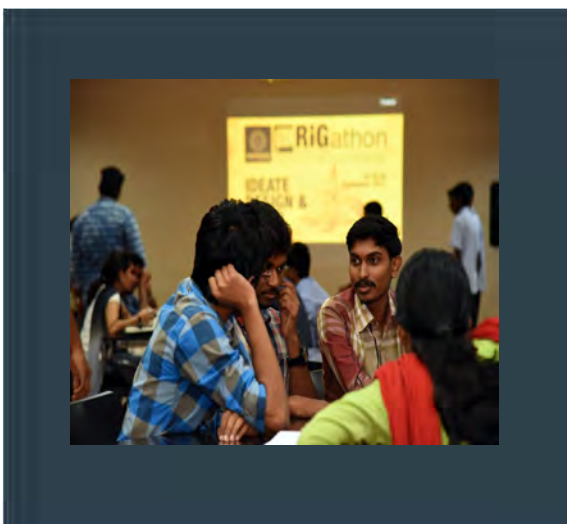
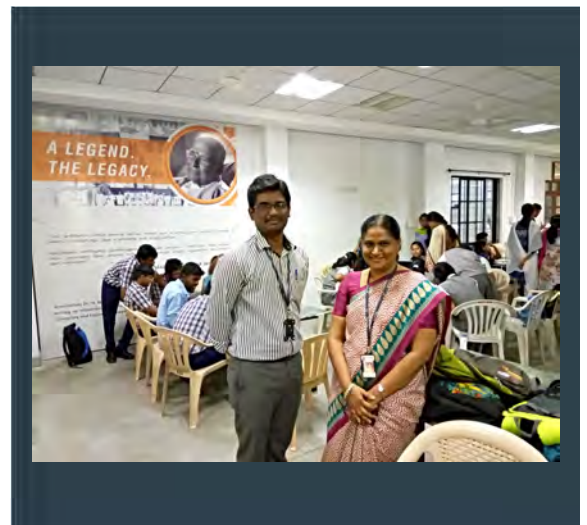


Dover Think-O- Fest

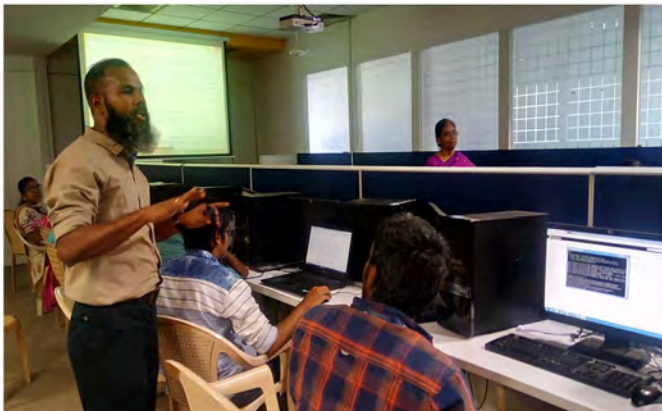
